Program Overview

Sessions include hands-on experiential and participatory learning taught and facilitated by published authors, national speakers and other distinguished leaders in their fields. Over the course of the program class members will meet and interact with key current community leaders, volunteers and elected officials. The program also builds upon long lasting business relationships gained by participation with the entire class.

During the opening retreat and the full day sessions (listed below), the class explores a segment of the community in-depth; visiting key locations such as the county jail, the local police department, schools, food pantries, as well as other area businesses, to get a clearer picture of the community in which they live and conduct business. Leadership and communication skills building initiatives are also a part of each session.

At every session, the class becomes more fully acquainted with the key issues facing our region, and gains a grasp of the interdependence of each sector and of the mutual understanding and cooperation needed among them for our community to grow and thrive. This awareness helps the class to design and implement a community project. From June through September, Leadership participants will complete their project and present it at the September graduation.
